The responsibilities of these positions can include preparation of grant applications, donor identification and management, coordination of annual campaigns and special fundraising events, solicitation of major gifts, and facilitation of planned giving. **Titles** can include development director; UAF campaign director; annual giving manager; fundraising coordinator; and development associate.
